

BNW - Don Quixote, 2019 - Final Notes

STRIKE NOTES:

Time: 4:30 - 6:30 pm at Washington Center. Finished at the shop by 7:30 pm

Strike Order:

Dry mop marley. Pull spikes (except for the white "zone" markers on the most US piece of marley.

Pull marley tape then roll on to tubes

Strike Lanterns - pack into boxes

Pack the Fogger in a garbage bag (to contain any fluid spills or leaks), then into box

Strike Swan Lake Legs and Borders, then the Moon Drop

Strike Don Q Proscenium, then Legs and Borders, then Full Drops

Procedures:

2 Legs were laid face to face — some were folded to decrease their width — then their accompanying Border was folded in half to decrease its length and laid atop the Legs. Then they were rolled onto a tube. So - 1 tube holds the full set - Legs and Border.

Forest Leg Sets were doubled up — 1 and 3 were rolled onto 1 tube. 2 and 4 were rolled onto 1 tube.

Storage Notes:

At the Shop, on the Racks... On the Left Side of the Rack Unit.....

MIDDLE RACK — All Don Q Dedicated goods — used ONLY for Don Q. Plus an old Moon Drop?

TOP RACK — All Swan Lake goods, plus the Don Q Forest Legs (which are used also for Swan Lake)

ON TOP OF THE RACK UNIT — 3 boxes of Lanterns, 2 Rolling Carts, 2 Chairs, Windmill Shadow Unit, Dowel Stiffeners (bundled and stored with the Shadow Unit)

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES:

The Table is broken and is mostly junk. It will need to be replaced. It is a pedestal table with a round top. Height = 26" Diameter of Top = 18"

I suggest that we start calling the Moon Drop "Swan Lake Moon Drop" and the other one the "Swan Lake Lake Drop" (it also has a moon on it) — Label these as such
